Frequently Asked Questions

Which horses have been chosen?

The horses to be leased are being selected by Haydock Park and The Jockey Club

Why are the horses being leased and not owned?

By leasing a horse it makes the whole enterprise more affordable allowing more benefits in other areas.

What if a horse is injured?

There are no guarantees in racing, but we are committed to having two leased horses in training at any time.

How do I get information about the horses?

We will regularly update members and share the horses' progress. When the club has a runner each member will be notified at entry stage and declaration stage. Haydock Park will keep the members informed of running plans via a circular email.

Will I make money?

Please do not expect a financial return from your membership but all prize money will be distributed, after costs, at the end of the term

Do I get a share of the prize money?

Each member has the right to a pro rata share of any surplus of funds at the end of the club term

I am a member at one of your courses already, can I offset the cost of that against this purchase?

Yes, Aintree, Haydock Park, and Carlisle members can, please call the membership team on 01942 402 609 and they will take you through your options

I don't want to go racing at Haydock Park but I'd like membership at Aintree, do I get a discount?

No, we are introducing this membership to encourage racing across our region and to support racing generally

Can I get out of the syndicate at any time and have my money back?

No, the membership is for 16 months (January 2018-April 2019) and is non-refundable

Can I give membership as a present?

Yes of course, please call Vikki Mason on 01942 402 609

When is the first stable visit?

Stable visits will be advised on a regular basis

Can I go into the paddock/enclosures when we have a runner?

Yes, we will distribute paddock passes by ballot (typically 6 per horse)

Do I get ownership access at the racecourse when we run?

Ownership passes will be distributed by ballot (typically 6 per horse). Each Member will be entitled to one complimentary Members badge whenever the club horses run at Haydock Park, Aintree or Carlisle.

Can I bring a guest racing for free?

With your JCHPRC badge you are entitled to invite up to three guests for half price County Stand tickets at Haydock Park, Carlisle and Aintree (excluding Friday and Saturday of the Grand National meeting).

Do I have a dedicated facility when one of our horses runs?

Where possible, at Jockey Club racecourse, a dedicated facility will be made available

Where is the exclusive facility at Haydock Park Racecourse?

The facility will move depending on the race day – all members will be advised of its location prior to the race day. All members will also be entitled to reserved parking

Do I have to pay for the Chairman's Annual Club Lunch?

No there is no cost attached and each member may bring a guest

When is the Chairman's Annual Club Lunch?

To be confirmed but potentially 12th May on the Swinton Hurdle Day when there are four flat and four jump races

Can I pay by monthly instalments?

Membership is subject to a one off payment of £1,980 (including VAT). A non refund able 10% deposit will be taken with your application of membership, with the remainder being taken on 30th November.

What happens if I commit with a 10% deposit and the club does not go ahead?

You will be refunded the 10% deposit.
